Alcohol Awareness for Manager and Supervisors - to provide support for managers in helping to recognise and respond to potential alcohol related issues in the workplace. The course can be tailored around existing policies the organisation may have in place.



Alcohol Awareness for Occupational Health and Human Resources - to provide support for workplace roles in contact with employees who may be drinking at risky levels and could benefit from brief advice, support or onwards referral. The course focuses on Intervention and Brief Advice (IBA), a simple and effective intervention proven to reduce alcohol misuse.



Open Enrolment Courses - similar aims to the courses offered above but 'open enrolment' to encourage representatives from a number of different workplaces. This course is designed with Small Medium Enterprises (SME's) in mind who may not have enough staff to warrant individual courses or indeed the facilities to do so.
